

PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA OFFICIAL CUSTOMS AUTHORITY
ADVANCE COMMERCIAL INFORMATION (ACI) AIR CARGO REPORTING

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 6, 2009

Effective immediately, prior to tendering and acceptance of freight, the following advance commercial information must be provided to Air Canada Cargo for forwarding to Chinese Customs (PVG, PEK).

China's Official Customs Authority requires exact shippers and consignees information on all imported merchandise, both at the Master Airway Bill Level and House Air Waybill Level.

The following information is required for both the Shipper and the Consignee:

- Full description of goods (e.g.: "NEWSPAPER" instead of "DOCUMENTS"; "Pharmaceutical Products" instead of "PHARMA")
- Complete name of Shipper and Consignee
- Street number and street name
- Full city name
- Full Province or State Name
- Country Name

Please be also advised that direct transmission by the customer is not authorized by Chinese Customs.
