a. Electronic Data Exchange (EDI): All House Air waybills (HAWBs) data submitted to Air Canada by EDI will be charged per HAWB - Code "CG"	\$3.50
For any inaccurate information that will need to be amended by Air Canada, a manual fee will be applied as listed below.	
b. Documentation (Air waybill/House Air waybill) for Air Canada to enter data into its own CBSA reporting system: All HAWB data that must be manually input by Air Canada will be charged per HAWB - Code "CC"	\$18.00
c. Direct data transmission to CBSA by Forwarder: No charge will be incurred if prior agreement has been made with Air Canada.
