- Express fee is applicable for all orders/changes made by the customer 3 or less calendar days prior to the required day.
- Express fee is applicable for all orders/changes made by the customer 5 or less calendar days prior to the required day when containers require positioning to shipment origin station (stations indicated on the Certified Station Listing)
- Express fee may be applicable for orders/changes made during weekends/holidays or if/when containers are required to be released to Air Canada Cargo the prior business day as a result of required day falling on a holiday or weekend.
- Additional day fee will be applicable for containers returned to Air Canada Cargo after the 5th day, regardless if the 5th day is a holiday.
- Orders must be placed by 12:00 (local time) to allow Air Canada Cargo sufficient time to process order.

* If a new required day is postponed, it must not exceed 7 days otherwise a cancellation fee applies. Two (2) changes to the required day are allowed - a 3rd change will result in a cancellation fee.
 ** Shipment cancellations must be provided in writing (via email) or submitted online.

- Container lease(s) are based in USD\$ per container and commence on the required pick-up day. The duration of the lease(s) is five (5) calendar days. The additional day fee will commence on the 6th day from the required day. All references to "days" are based on calendar days unless otherwise stated.
- Containers must be returned in the same condition they were released. In the event of damages (internal or external, including markings/labels that are difficult to remove or missing adapters), and where it has been determined that such damage was caused by the customer, additional charges may apply.
- Shipments may be subject to customs delays in some countries such as Brazil. Additional day fees may apply.
- For t2 containers, 16 D-Cell Alkaline Batteries, the applicable amount of dry ice and a copy of the Dry Ice Calculation Sheet are to be supplied by the customer at shipment origin. If/when batteries are required to be replaced, Air Canada Cargo will do so at the cost of USD\$50 per 16 batteries. If/when dry ice is required to be replenished, Air Canada Cargo will do so (calculations provided by customer) at a cost of USD\$6/kg with a USD\$100 minimum.
- Positioning/Return Fee of USD\$500 per container is applicable for all shipments that originate from or are destined to any of the following locations: BOG, DXB, EZE, GRU, HKG, ICN, LIM, NRT and SCL. Refer to AC Absolute[®] Certified Locations List on our website.
- The extended tender/retrieval fees are per hour and per ULD. They are applicable for shipments that are tendered more than 12 hours prior to flight departure or that continue to remain at an Air Canada Cargo warehouse or GHA after 24 hours after flight arrival. This fee will not apply for shipments that are delayed in South America. This fee is separate and in addition to any storage charges which may be applicable as a result of shipments not being retrieved at destination within 24 hours.
- Non-Air Canada Cargo lease handling fees are per container and applicable for shipments moving on Air Canada yet where active containers are not leased through Air Canada Cargo.
