QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- Q1. When will the Air Canada gift cards be available for sale on www.aircanada.com/agents?
 By the end of Q3 2013.
- Q2. Apart from using the gift card as a form of payment on the North American consumer and agency websites, where else can customers use the gift cards?
 - Customers can use the electronic gift cards as a form of payment on any ac2u platforms and Call Centres.
 - Customers can use the plastic gift cards as a form of payment on any ac2u platforms and Call Centres. Airport ticket and check-in counters will accept the plastic gift cards by the end of June 2013.
- Q3. Can customers use the gift cards with another form of payment?

 Yes, the gift card can be used with another form of payment, *provided* the gift card is the first method of payment.
- Q4. Is there a maximum number of gift cards that can be used per transaction?

 For ticket purchases, customers may use up to two gift cards provided that the total cost of the ticket purchase is covered fully by the two gift cards. When purchasing a seat or travel option for an existing reservation, only one form of payment will be accepted.
- Q5. Can purchases made using the gift card as a form of payment be voided? No and must be handled as a refund (providing the product or service is refundable).
- Q6. Can purchases made using the gift card as a form of payment be refunded?

 Yes providing the product or service is refundable. If eligible, the refund will be processed to the original gift card.
- Q7. Will agencies earn a commission for gift cards purchased via www.aircanada.com/agents?
 No, the sale of a gift card does not attract a commission payment as it is a form of payment.
- Q8. What happens if a customer loses his/her gift card can it be replaced? No, there is no name assigned to the card.
