Scholarship applications will be accepted as of November 1, 2019. The Captain Judy Cameron Scholarship—awarded by Air Canada—targets women who are Canadian citizens and who have either been accepted, are enrolled or are considering a post-secondary aviation flight program or aircraft repair and maintenance program.

2. Essay:

In 750 words or less tell us about yourself and include the following details:

- Your immediate (5 year) and future (10 year) goals, indicating your commitment to career in aviation.
- Your plan to achieve your goals and the steps you've taken so far to achieve them.
- Your challenges and setbacks—how you have handled adversity in any area of your life?
- Your participation in organizations that promote women in aviation and any other volunteer work.
- Please provide any other additional information that makes your application stand out from other applicants

3. Case for financial support:

Please provide the following information about your current financial status:

- Facility costs—hourly rates for instructor, aircraft, simulator and/or tuition per semester at college or university.
- List any other source of funding, scholarships, or awards you are receiving.
- Total funds currently saved?
- Funding for previous training
- Access to Parental Assistance or Spousal support—if applicable, please indicate the amount received.
- Cost of living (residence or other rent)
- Amount of current student debt
- List any unusual expenses that should be considered in the assessment of your financial need.

4. Reference letters:

Please provide two letters of reference that meet the following criteria:

- Cannot be a family member or spouse
- The letters should detail your specific skills, aptitude and performance
- For pilots, one of the reference letters should be by someone who you have flown with you.
